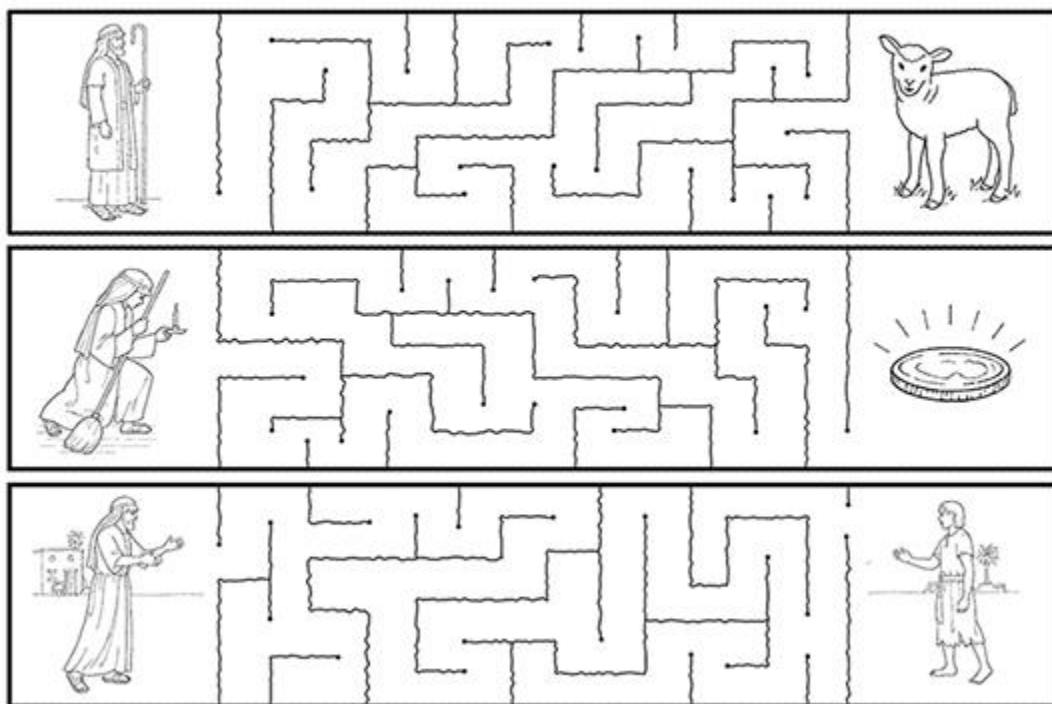

Help the shepherd find his lost sheep, the woman find her lost coin, and the father find his lost son.







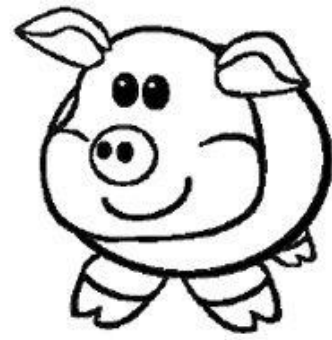




The Parable of the Lost Son
